Subject Mill District Development Transportation Impacts

Recommended Action(s): Receive report

Background:

The proposed Mill District development is currently going through a series of Planning Commission workshops. The project will include Healdsburg Avenue frontage improvements from Exchange Avenue to the terminus of the Roundabout Project improvements. The project southerly limits extend to the McDonalds and the easterly improvements terminate along the railroad right of way.

Discussion:

The project location falls within the Central Healdsburg Area Plan, and is a vital hub for transportation. The project connects with the new roundabout, the future SMART station, and the Foss Creek Trail. The Transportation Advisory Commission requests the opportunity to review the project and provide input.
