**Description:** Major Design Review for a new 4-story, 16 guest room hotel with commercial space and a restaurant on the ground floor. The project proposes valet only parking and 34 onsite parking spaces with access via a drive aisle off Healdsburg Avenue.

The project includes demolition of all existing buildings on site.
