I. GENERAL

THIS STANDARD HAS BEEN DEVELOPED FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLEARLY IDENTIFYING AND MARKING PROPER ADDRESSES PURSUANT TO UNIFORM FIRE CODE SECTION 10.208 AS ADOPTED BY THE HEALDSBURG CITY COUNCIL.

IN ADDITION TO INDIVIDUAL BUILDING SUITES OR APARTMENT NUMERALS OR LETTER, CONDOMINIUMS, APARTMENT COMPLEXES, TOWNHOUSES, MOBILE HOME PARKS AND MULTIPLE COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS SHALL HAVE INSTALLED AT POINTS OF ENTRY A PERMANENT DIRECTORY SIGN

II. SPECIFICATIONS

THE DIRECTORY SIGN SHALL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:

- A. A PLOT PLAN SHOWING PRIVATE ROADS AND PARKING LOTS.
- B. BUILDING LOCATIONS WITH UNIT NUMBERS AND ADDRESSES.
- C. FIRE HYDRANT LOCATIONS.
- D. NAME OF THE COMPLEX.
- E. A REFERENCE POINT ON THE PLOT PLAN INDICATING THE LOCATION OF THE DIRECTORY
- F. A NORTH DIRECTION INDICATOR.

THE DEVELOPER OR THE PROPERTY OWNER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL A DETAILED PLAN SHOWING SIZE, MATERIALS, METHOD OF CONSTRUCTION AND LOCATION OF INSTALLATION.

NOTE: ALL SITE MAPS ARE SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE PLANNING DEPT.

MINIMUM DIMENSIONS OF THE DIRECTORY ARE AS SHOWN
