
IV. ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ANALYSIS

A. IMPACTS FOUND TO BE LESS THAN SIGNIFICANT

Section 15128 of the CEQA Guidelines requires that an EIR shall contain a statement briefly indicating the reasons that various possible significant effects of a project were determined not to be significant and were therefore not discussed in detail in the EIR. Sections IV.B through IV.P of this Revised Draft EIR discuss all potential impacts, regardless of their magnitude. A similar level of analysis is provided for impacts found to be less than significant as impacts found to be significant. Significance of an impact is assessed in relation to the significance criteria provided in Sections IV.B through IV.P of this Revised Draft EIR. A summary of all impacts is provided in Table II-1 in Section II (Summary) of this Revised Draft EIR.
